MENTOR - MENTEE POLICY

All students enrolled in the college will be part of the programme. Senior teachers are appointed as mentors to guide and nurture students. Each student is assigned a mentor for the entire duration of study in the institution. A mentee profile is maintained by the mentor which is kept strictly confidential. An academic progress report card is maintained along side the mentee profile to track the mentee's development and progress. The mentors convene meeting with the mentee in the 1st, 3rd and 5th semester and convene meeting with the parent/guardian in the 2nd, 4th and 6th semester.

OBJECTIVES

- To guide students at a personal level and to monitor beyond the academic progress of the students.
- to identify the strength and weakness in the personal life of the student and provide guidance accordingly.
- to improve human interaction in the campus.
- to minimize dropouts by ensuring that students achieves emotional stability and motivation, better discipline, better academic profile and increased participation in all the activities of the college and beyond.
- to provide personal counseling in complete confidence and reference for corrective measures.
- to keep the parents/guardians updated on their child/ward performance.
- To offer corrective measures to erring students and motivation to others.

GUIDELINES

Mentors will be nominated by the Mentoring cell and appointed by the Principal. A mentor shall be a senior teacher having completed atleast eight years of teaching experience. The mentor should maintain the institutional code of conduct as teachers and keep the relationship strictly professional. The mentor shall retain the mentee's informations under strict confidentiality and inform the appropriate authority as and when situation demands. Mentees must always treat their mentors as their teacher first and give due respect and honor.

THE PROGRAMME

Alder College Mentoring programme was initiated in 2014 as one of the the institution's best practices. The success of the programme has been evidenced by improvement in overall performance of the students. It has been observed that a desirable improvement in the student's attendance has taken place. Mutual respect among the students and between student-teacher has also been facilitated. The programme has brought about a humanizing environment on campus and at the same time helped the students to be closer and open to the teachers. It has motivated students to be participatory in the activities conducted by the college. The mentors has been able to motivate the potential performers to consistently do well in studies. This programme has resulted in improved discipline and helped in improving behavioural attitude. It has helped to resolve conflict between student- student, students-teachers, students-staff. It has increased the confidence of the parents in the teachers
