

## Annual Report of 2021-2022

- Due to the pandemic, physical classes were suspended wef. 30th April till July 2021. However, online classes were conducted during the period till the completion of syllabi.
- Online Examinations were conducted by Nagaland University for BA 6th Semester wef. 27th May, and for BA 2nd and BA 4th semester wef. 14th June 2021.
- Online classes for BA 3rd and BA 5th Semesters started on 14th July 2021. Class XI and BA 1st Semester classes began on 17th August 2021.
